Luxurious African themed treehouses and bungalows are located alongside animal enclosures where guests can sleep next to a lion, feed a giraffe from their balcony or gaze into shark tank — Jamala offers an unforgettable immersive wildlife experience.

The experience starts from check-in; hosted by the black and white Colobus Monkeys, enjoy hightea before going on a guided tour of the zoo to experiencing hands on interactions with some of our residents. 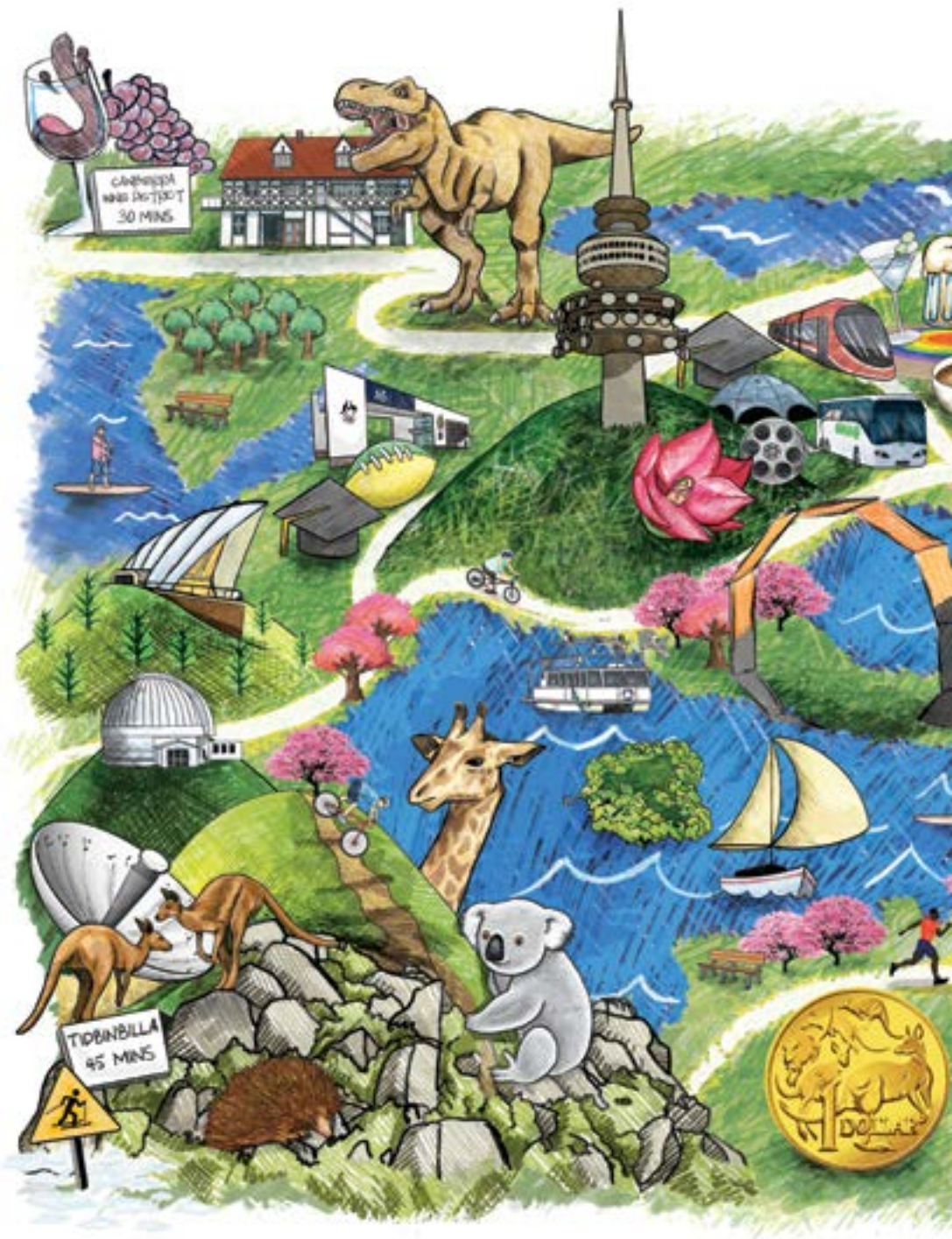

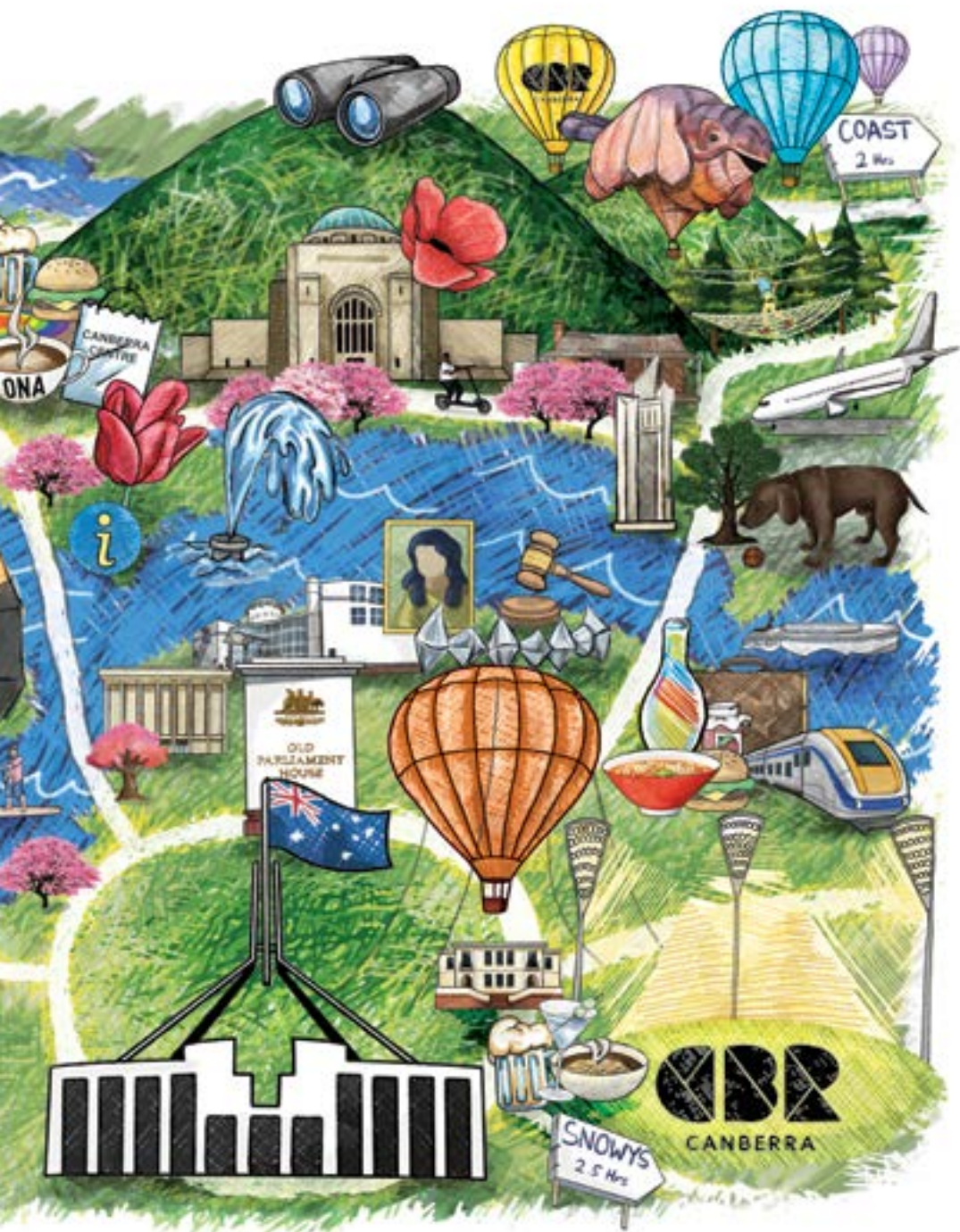
